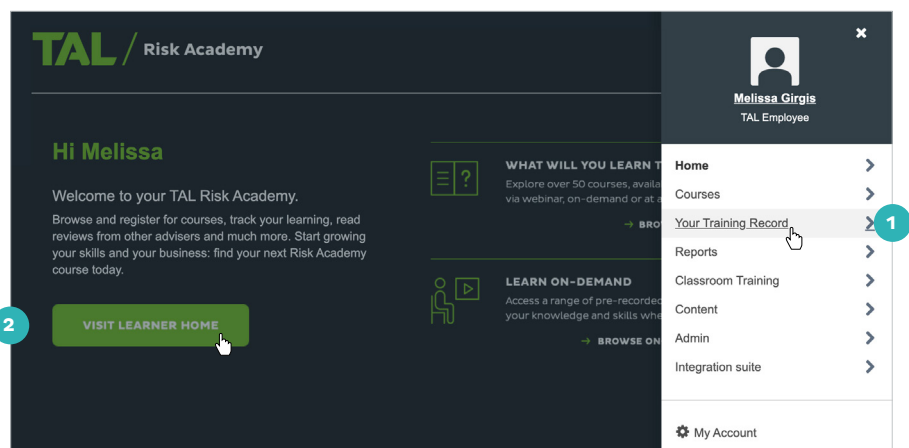

### Find your test

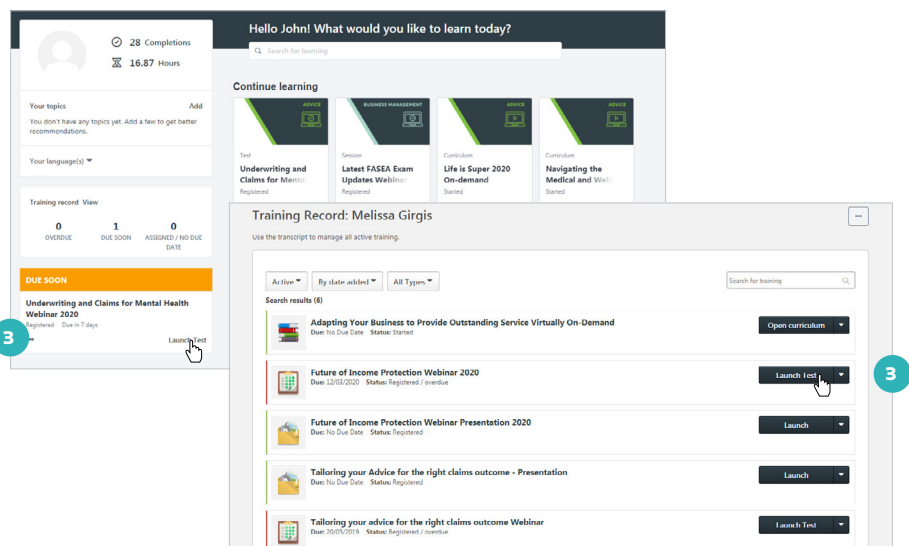
Get started by logging in to the TAL Risk Academy at [riskacademy.tal.com.au](http://riskacademy.tal.com.au).

Once you've logged in, you can either:

- 1 Click 'Your Training Record' in the top navigation
- 2 Or click 'Visit Learner Home'



- 3 From Your Training Record or Learner Home, click 'Launch Test' next to the course you've attended.

- 8 The results page shows whether you've passed the exam and also allows you review your answers by clicking 'Review'
- 9 Click 'Done' to go back to Your Training Record where you can restart the test if you didn't pass or access your course certificate if you did.
